These are a list of the Bills I'll be tracking on for the 2017 session related to Emergency Management as part of my role as the current "Past President". If any of you think I missed one, please don't hesitate to throw me a bone and direct me to the bill of interest. Have a great weekend.

Senate

SB 61 – Expands the OERS Council

SB 62 – Amends intrastate mutual assistance

SB 109 – Oregon's Earthquake Insurance Task Force

SB 310 – Authorizes city/county as Vertical Housing Development Zone

SB 311 – Authorizes city/county to adopt ordinance/resolution property tax to commercial, industrial and multifamily buildings – seismically retrofitted

SB 312 – Requires seller of real property to disclose seismic risk in seller's property disclosure statement

SB 456 – Enacts Emergency Medical Services personnel licensure interstate compact

House

HB 2140 – Requires seller of real property to disclose seismic risk in seller's property disclosure statement

HB 2164 – Requires municipalities – enforcing building inspections

HB 2168 – Requires municipalities or business employing person to perform state building codes to provide equipment for performance of inspections

HB 2209 – Establishes Task Force on Housing Supply

HB 2241 – Extends sunset for Task Force on Drought Emergency Response

HB 2288 – Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds for Connect Oregon

HB 2447 – Directs State Board of Education to adopt standards: certain persons employed to have valid cert in CPR/1st Aid

HB 2473 – Establishes grant program to facilitate installation of self-service dispensing devices in low-population counties

HB 2482 – Removes hours of operation restriction on self-service at filling stations

HB 2532 – Directs OR Trans Commission to adopt rules establishing quantitative system for scoring/raking trans projects

HB 2574 – Directs OEM to identify strategies for improving access to emergency preparedness education

HB 2687 – Directs OEM and OR Homeland Security Council to develop grant program to distribute preparedness equipment to local government, establishes 'Resiliency Grant Fund' using article XI-Q bonding
