## Basecamp Proposal:

OEMA has been challenged to collaborate across the state and with diverse group of organizations. The lack of homogenous organizations prevent traditional file sharing and collaboration tools such as SharePoint. OEMA has been asked by our members to provide a document library to share best practices, case studies, and example documents. Furthermore, OEMA hosts an annual conference, which is planned via conference call and email.

### Basecamp Provides:

- File sharing
- Task lists (assign, complete, due dates)
- Message board
- Schedules
- Real-time group chat
- Check-in tools

Basecamp can provide a solution to the aforementioned challenges faced by OEMA for an annual price of \$99 per month (Approximately \$1200 per year).

Additionally, OEMA could make Basecamp available to counties or cities to have their own folder to support their collaboration needs for project management work. Likely project management work could include:

- Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan
- Emergency Operations Plan
- Other planning processes
- Training schedules and documents
- Multi-jurisdictional projects

A potential cost apportionment could look like this:

City or County jurisdiction could add Basecamp benefits by paying an enhanced membership for \$50 per year. This would offset a significant portion of OEMA's cost of Basecamp and allow OEMA to provide the service for statewide benefit.
