OEM is interested in our feedback with regard to the State EOP – Matt will send out to all counties and tribes for feedback. Small feedback in fine, but large ideas will have to go into the next update structure since it won't be enough time to research the request before it's due to be promulgated. We'll hopefully see this next week. The State EOP is evaluated each year and updated every two years.

Mike Lueck sits on the Oregon Emergency Response System (OERS) council on behalf of OEMA as a liaison

OEM will announce the new Deputy Director by Friday, January 27. (Later that week, Matt Marheine was announced Deputy Director)

Oregon Preparedness planning comes from feedback from the previous year.
